NOTICE OF RACE

An invitation is extended to owners of eligible Ocean Racing, Cruising and Trailable Yachts to enter the 4RO "ROUND THE BAY" Race, starting on Saturday 29th November 2008 at 1000hrs from Rosslyn Bay, Yeppoon.

1. RULES

The race will be sailed under the rules of the I.S.A.F., the prescriptions of the A.Y.F, the QYA Special Safety Regulations and the race Sailing Instructions.

2. DIVISIONS

The race will be conducted in three divisions, depending on entries.

- (a) Division 1 - Monohull Racing
- (b) Division 2 - Trailer Sailer/Cruising
- (c) Division 3 - Multihulls

3. ELIGIBILITY

3.1 The event is open to all monohull, multihull and trailable yachts, which are on the register of an AYF affiliated Yacht Club.

3.2 All yachts competing shall comply with QYA Special Safety Regulations for Category 4.

3.3 Eligible boats may enter on the Entry Form which shall be lodged with

4. FEES

4.1 Entry Fee \$15.00 (GST inclusive) must accompany Entry Form.

4.2 Late Entries **may** be accepted Friday 27th November.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be issued at the race briefing.

7. RACING AREA

7.1 The racing area shall be Keppel Bay.

8. COURSE

8.1 The course shall start near Rosslyn Bay

The course proceeds in a south easterly direction from the

Start at Rosslyn Bay then to
Bluff Rock (to port) thence to
No.4 buoy, approx.2 miles north of Sea Hill (to port) to
Child Island (to port) then to
Great Keppel Island (to port) then to
Myall Island (to port), then to
Bluff Rock (to starboard) then to
the finish off the NORTHERN BREAKWATER at Rosslyn Bay .

8.2 Alternative Course for each Division may be advised at the race briefing.

9. ALTERNATIVE PENALTIES

9.1 The 720 Turns penalty of the racing rules will apply. (Rule 44.2)

10. DECISIONS OF THE JURY

10.1 Decisions of the Jury will be final in accordance with racing rule 70.4.

11. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

11.1 All radio communications shall be carried out on VHF Ch 73.

11.2 A Race Radio Schedule will be advised in the Sailing Instructions.

11.3 Radio Schedules will be conducted by SV Casper in alphabetical order. At conclusion of schedule Casper may ask for assistance to relay vessels positions.

11.4 A yacht shall neither make radio transmission while racing nor receive radio (or any other electronic device) communication not available to all yachts.

12. PRIZES

12.1 Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each division if numbers justify.

12.2 The major sponsor for this race is 4RO

12.2 Prizes will be awarded at the CCYC Annual Presentation Night (August 2009)
