



Port Curtis Sailing Club
Marina Berth Policy

Rationale

- Port Curtis Sailing Clubs arrangement with the Gladstone Marina provides discounted marina berths for members.

Scope

- This arrangement is renewed annually therefore the availability of the discount, the discount rate and the number of berths may vary.
- The number of berths available may be limited by the Marina or PCSC.
- PCSC may charge an administration fee.
- The maximum number of berths and the administration fee will be determined by the PCSC executive committee.
- This arrangement is under the standard terms and conditions of the Marina berthing contracts.
- The arrangement is for a minimum of 12 months and does not include liveaboards.

Criteria

- The applicant must be an Ordinary or Life member of Port Curtis Sailing.
- The applicant must have paid their membership fee.
- There is a limit of one berth per member.
- Preference will be given to active members (those who sail regularly in club events and/or contribute to the running of club events) according to the following:
 1. to race nominated yachts that have completed 50% of races in the past immediate season or the season before that.
 2. to the vessel of a member who has crewed on a yacht for 50% of races in the immediate past season or the season before that or who has assisted in an equivalent number of days in race support activities or training programs over the immediate past season or the season before that.
 3. to other racing or cruising vessels
 4. to the vessels of other members based on length of membership. (Junior membership will be used when determining duration.)
- Overriding the above: the executive of PCSC may lower the priority of a member who has not paid any fees by their due date.

Applications must be submitted in writing to the Secretary Manager and will be approved at the discretion of the Executive committee of Port Curtis Sailing Club.

The number of marina berths is limited to 25.

This policy was adopted 1st June 2006. It is the responsibility for interested sailors to confirm the currency of the policy.
