



Port Curtis Sailing Club
Travel Assistance Policy

Rationale

- This policy is to support and encourage sailors of Port Curtis Sailing Club compete and represent the club at State level and higher.

Scope

- This policy covers travel assistance only.
- Assistance will be determined after consideration of the distance and mode of travel involved.
- Assistance will be considered for
 - Sabot Sailors
 - To attend SQSA selection trials
 - To attend the Sabot National Titles
 - To attend Sabot Week
 - All other Sailors
 - To attend the State, National or World titles of a Yachting Australia recognized class.
- Assistance will be to a maximum of \$500 per member or \$1000 per vessel per event.
- A maximum of two (2) applications per annum will be approved for an individual and/or vessel.

Criteria

- The sailor must be an Ordinary or Junior member of Port Curtis Sailing Club and have sailed one full season with the club (at least 50% of the races).
- The sailor must be representing Port Curtis Sailing Club at the event.
- The request must be submitted to the secretary manager at least 14 days prior to leaving Gladstone.
- The sailor must submit a budget of their travel costs and details of their request including how they meet the criteria and responsibilities of this policy.

Responsibilities: any member so supported is expected to contribute to the club through

- Assisting with Learn-to-Sail or running special coaching clinics for appropriate groups.
- Actively promoting their campaign in the local media. (An article before the event and one with results after the event. Photographs to be submitted.)
- Providing an article for the club newsletter.

Each application must be submitted to the Secretary Manager at least 14 days prior to the event and will be approved at the discretion of the Executive committee of Port Curtis Sailing Club.
