



## Port Curtis Sailing Club Policy: Average Points Claim

### Purpose

To provide clear reference to Members in regard to claiming average points.

### Rationale

1. Competitors in the Port Curtis Sailing Club Handicap, Rated Handicap and Sprint Series can submit an application to claim for average points if they cannot race on one race of the series due to sailing conflicts.

The claim is to be submitted to the Sailing Committee before the date in question.

The application must document how the competitor meets the Criteria requirements for the claim to be considered.

**(Applications must be submitted in writing to the Sailing Committee and will be approved at the discretion of the Sailing Committee of the Port Curtis Sailing Club).**

2. Skippers assisting Race management as designated Principal Race Officer or required to crew on support vessels will be awarded average points for each race in their division that was to be sailed that day.

The average points will be recognised on the result sheet of the race/races of that particular day.

### Criteria

- The absence must be due to State, National, or International Championships, or WS graded events for Olympic dinghy classes.  
Additionally, for yachts representing PCSC participating in off shore events.
- The absence is for the nominated person/vessel only. i.e. not for family member commitments.
- Reasonable transport time to and from the event will be considered.
- Only one sailing day in a series can be claimed as average points.
- The series in question must have a minimum of two races in total.
- The absence is due to PRO roster duties or crewing support boats.
